

Under Article 13 D.Lgs 196/2003 "Code of protection of personal data" and in relation to personal data that Lago will hold, please note the following:

1. According to the law defined above, this treatment will be based on principles of correctness, lawfulness and transparency and protection of privacy and rights of the owner of the personal data.
2. The treatment is performed through the operations or transactions mentioned in Article. 4 part 1 letter. a) of the D.Lgs n. 196/2003: collection, recording, organizing, storing, retrieving, processing, modification, selection, extraction, comparison, use, interconnection, blocking, communication, cancellation and destruction of personal data.
3. The operations can be performed with or without the aid of electronic or other automated means.
4. The treatment is done by the holder and by the processor of the treatment.
5. The conferment of data is optional, except for the data under Article. 24, lett. a) of D.Lgs n. 196/2003 in relation to which the conferment is required. The refusal by the individual to give these data may prevent the establishment and / or continuing of the relationship with the customer.
6. In the activities done by Lago SrL, may communicate such personal data to its managers, controller and officers and third parties and / or companies of the respective Group.
7. The responsible of the treatment, in the person of legal representative pro tempore are Lago SrL, established in Gazzada Schianno (VA), via Adua n. 22.

At any time, the owner of the personal data can exercise his rights towards the data controller under Article. 7 of D.Lgs 196/2003, which is transcribed below in full:

*Art. 7 - Right to access personal data and other rights 1. The owner of personal data has the right to obtain confirmation of the existence or not of personal data concerning him, even if not yet recorded and their communication in intelligible form. 2. The owner of the personal data has the right to obtain indication about: a) the origin of personal data b) the purposes and methods of treatment c) the logic applied in case of treatment done with the aid of electronic instruments d) the identification of the owner, the controller and the representative appointed under article 5, paragraph 2 e) the subjects or categories of persons to whom personal data may be communicated or who can learn about them as appointed representative in the State, managers or agents. 3. The owner of personal data has the right to: a) updating, rectification or, when interested, integration of data, b) the cancellation, transformation into anonymous form or blocking of data processed unlawfully, including those which need not be kept for the purposes for which the data were collected or subsequently processed; c) certification that the operations in letters a) and b) have been disclosed, including their contents, to those to whom the data were communicated or disseminated, unless this requirement proves impossible or involves a manifestly disproportionate to the protected right. 4. The owner of personal data has the right to oppose, wholly or partially a) for legitimate reasons concerning the processing of personal data, pertinent to the purpose of collection b) the processing of personal data for purposes of sending advertising materials or direct selling or for carrying out market researches or commercial communication.*
